

Articles in English are the following: (the\ a\ an)

We need to consider the following points regarding the use of (a) and (an):

1. Both articles (a) and (an) are used before singular nouns, for example:

- An apple
- A teacher

2. Using (a) or (an) is determined by the first sound\ letter of the noun. If the noun starts with a consonant sound, we use (a). If the noun starts with a vowel sound, we use (an). For example:

- An actor
- A student

2. Sometimes, the noun is proceeded by adjectives. In this case, we use (a) if the first sound of the adjective is consonant, and we use (an) if the first sound of the adjective is vowel. For example:

- A <u>b</u>lue ink
- An <u>untidy</u> room
