This initiative is part of Al-Hamdaniya University's commitment to supporting programs aimed at achieving sustainable development and enhancing the role of educational institutions in serving the community.





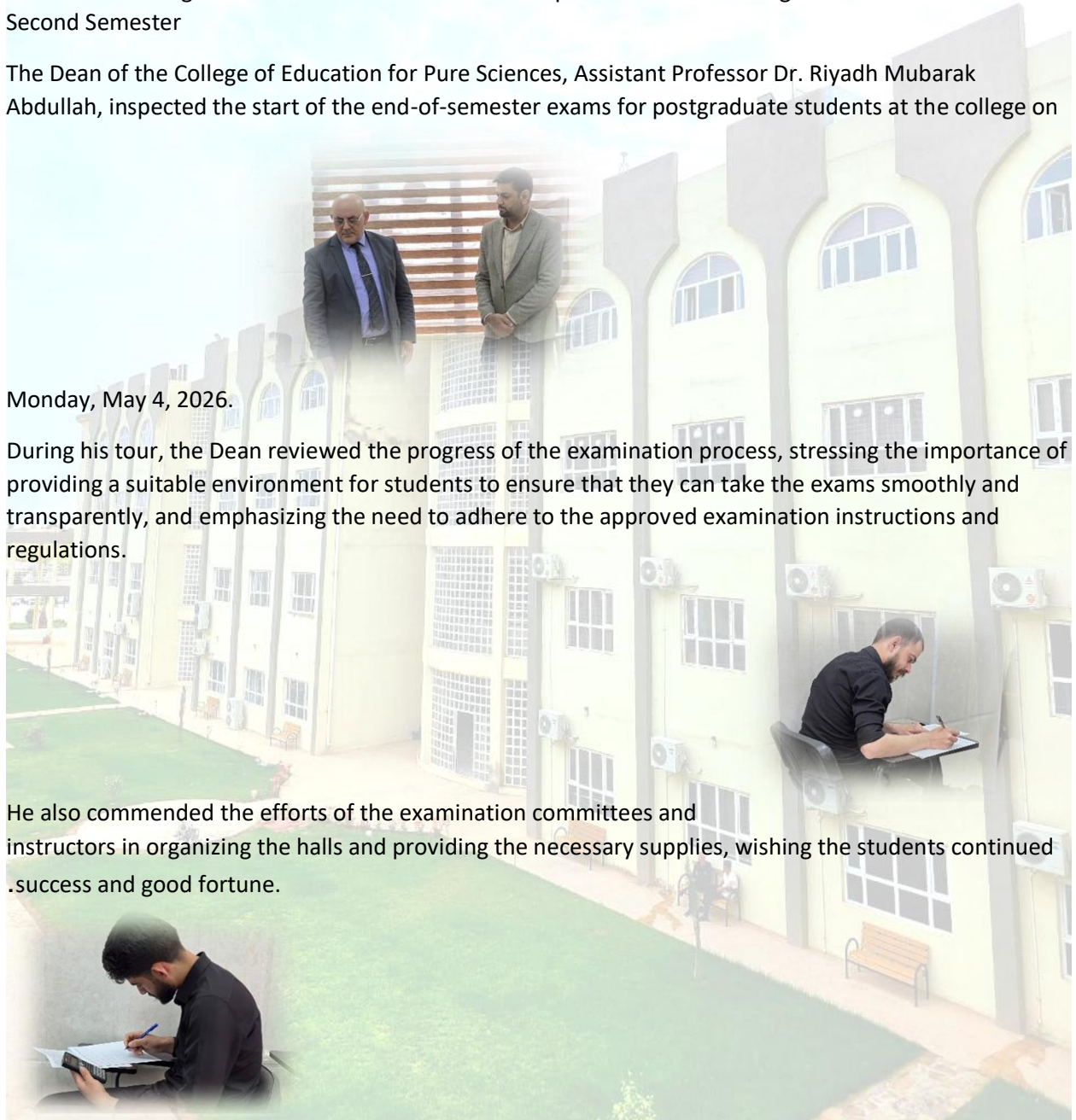
## Dean of the College of Education for Pure Sciences Inspects the Start of Postgraduate Exams for the Second Semester

For his part, the Dean praised the university administration's ongoing support and its commitment to monitoring the educational and examination processes, which contributes to raising the students' academic level.

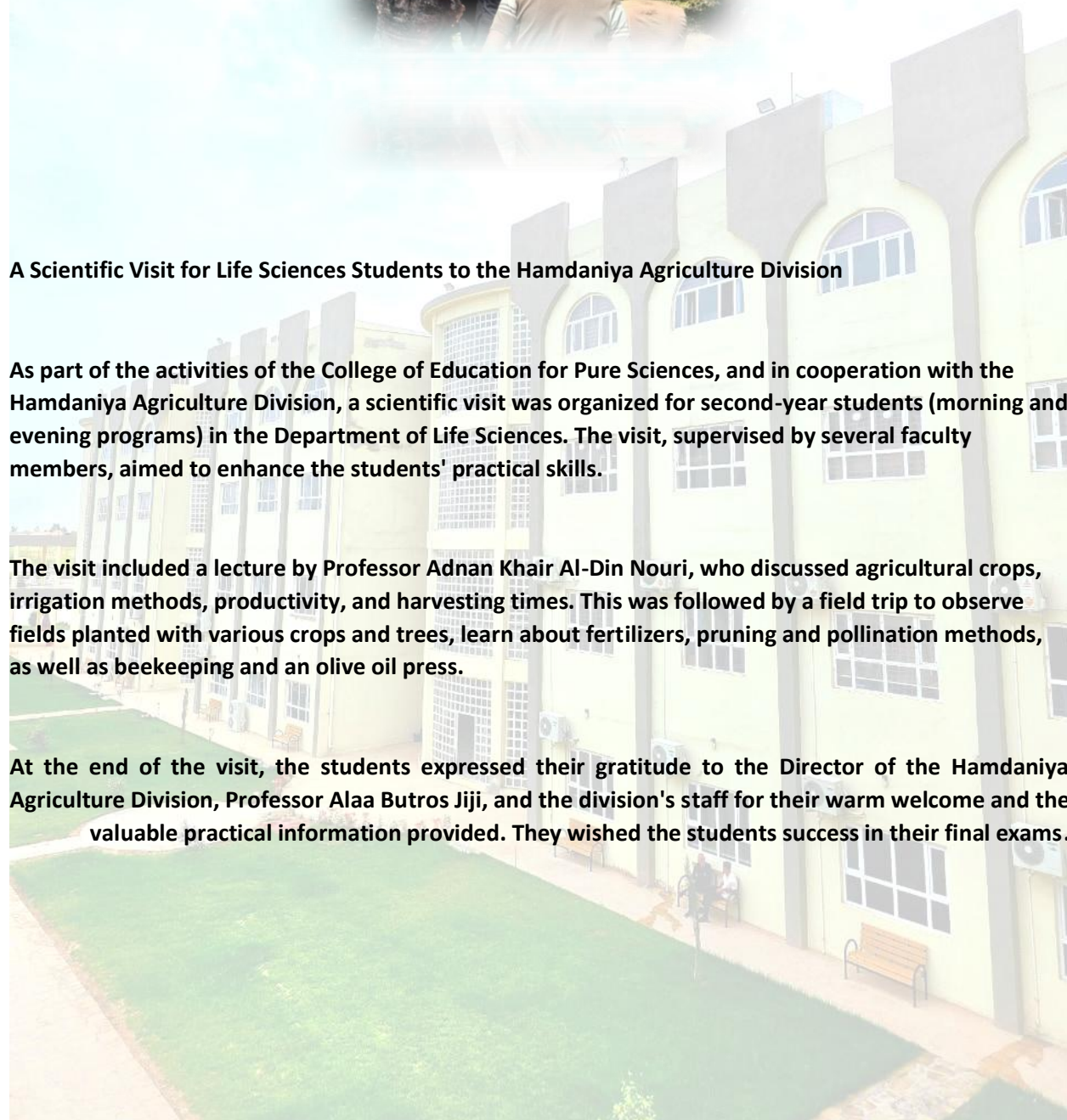


### **A Scientific Visit for Life Sciences Students to the Hamdaniya Agriculture Division**

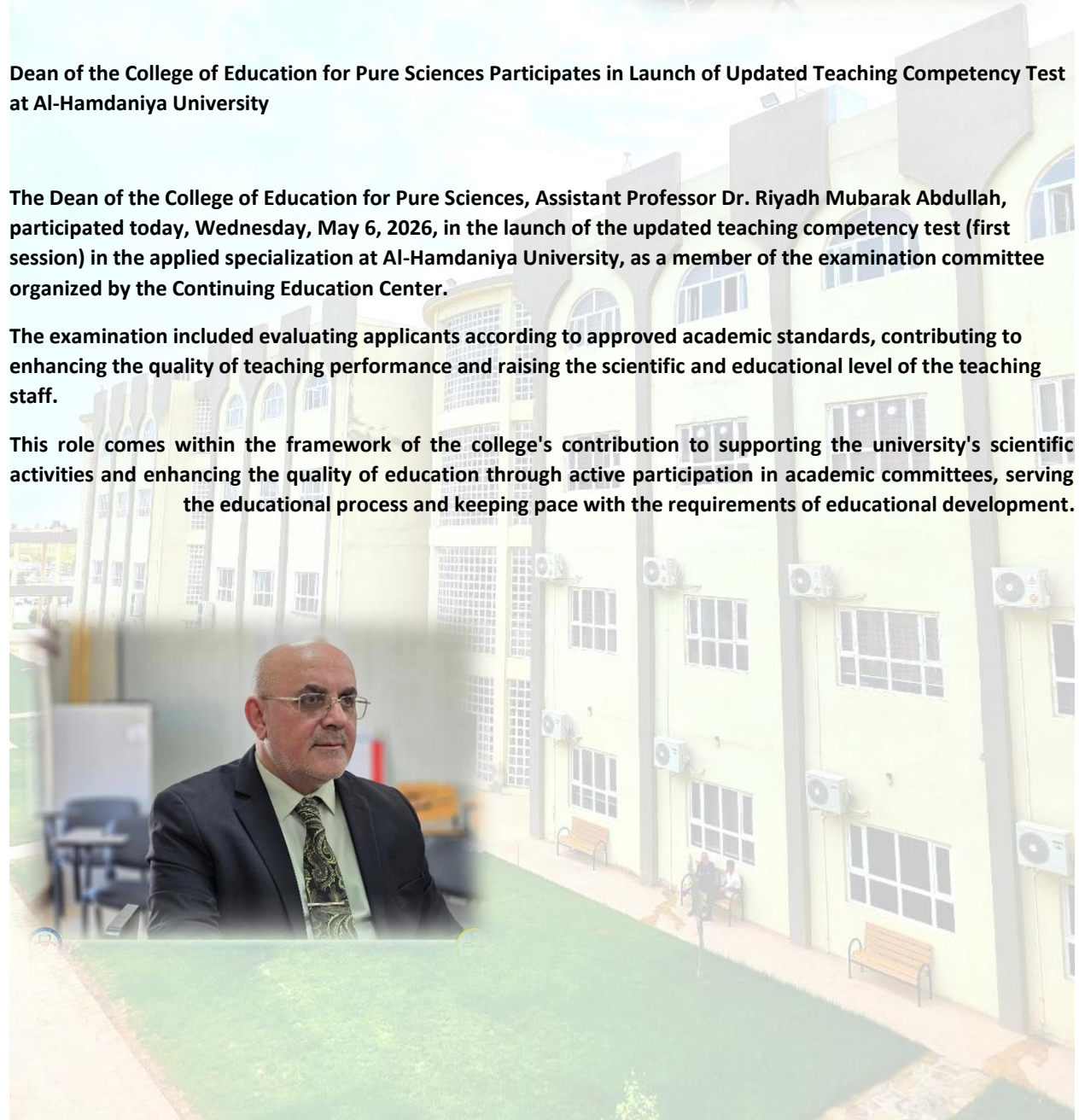


**Dean of the College of Education for Pure Sciences Participates in Launch of Updated Teaching Competency Test at Al-Hamdaniya University**

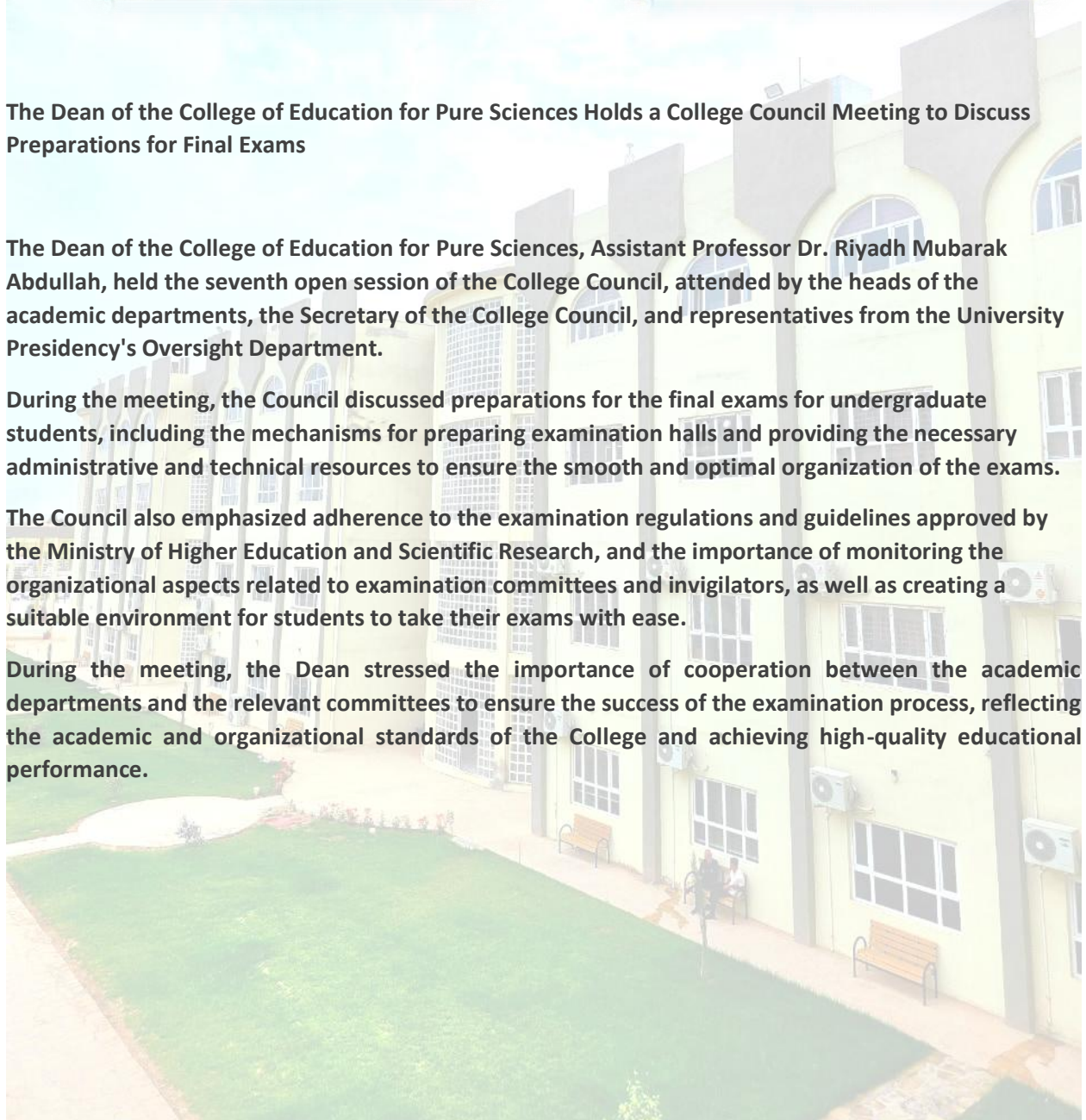
### **The Dean of the College of Education for Pure Sciences Holds a College Council Meeting to Discuss Preparations for Final Exams**

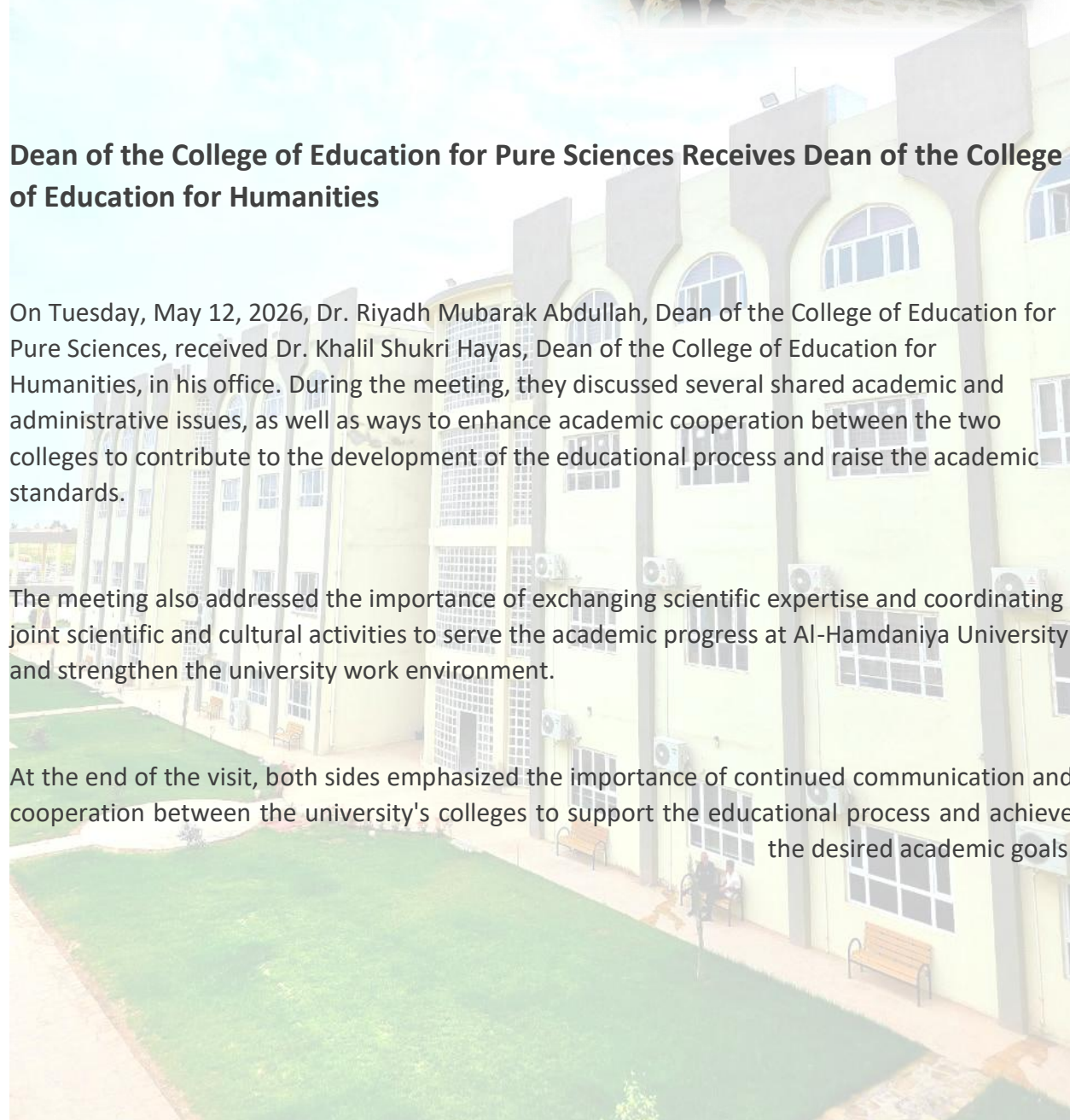


## **Dean of the College of Education for Pure Sciences Receives Dean of the College of Education for Humanities**

At the end of the visit, both sides emphasized the importance of continued communication and cooperation between the university's colleges to support the educational process and achieve the desired academic goals.

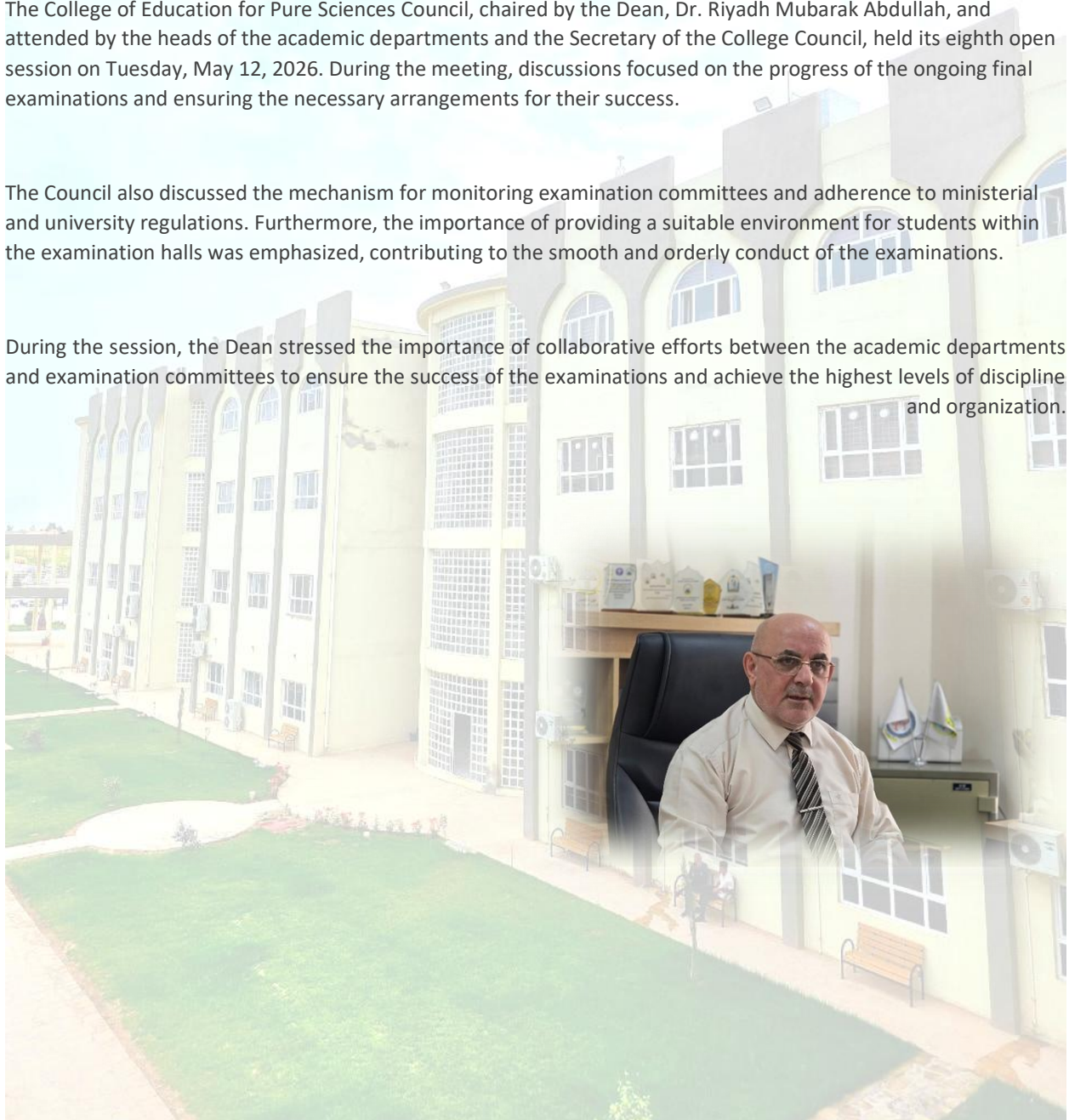


## The College of Education for Pure Sciences Council Holds its Eighth Open Session
